Make

Students will select the materials that they will use to make their own dream catcher

Students will mark out and measure materials needed

Students will use tools ~(scissors) to cut out the materials.

Students will need to use a trial and error approach to make their dream catcher



Evaluate

Students will evaluate materials to see which are most suitable for their projects

Students will look at their designs and say what are good and what could be improved in them.

Students will be able to state which design will be the most successful and why.

Students will evaluate their work to see the successes and failures in their work.

Students will communicate how they could improve their design, should they complete it again.

Key Vocabulary

Research - investigation into and study of materials and sources in order to establish facts and reach new conclusions:

Weave - interlacing long threads passing in one direction with others at a right angle to them:

Dream catcher - is a handmade willow hoop, on which is woven a net or web

Material - the matter from which a thing is or can be made

Design - a plan or drawing produced to show the look

Evaluation - Assessment of how an product works compared with its supposed to do.



Design
